In accordance with the Clery Act and the Violence Against Women Act, Indiana Academy of Massage is committed to providing a campus experience that supports the safety of our students, our staff, and our guests. Any form of sexual harassment, sexual assault, domestic violence, and dating violence will not be tolerated. Our school supports this mission by offering ongoing awareness and prevention events.

Additionally, all incoming and current students and staff are also provided written information about campus safety via the student catalog, employee orientations and employee handbook. The ultimate purpose of this is to promote safe and healthy student relationships that fosters a positive learning environment for everyone.

The school prepares an Annual Safety Report in compliance with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Crime Statistics Act. This report is prepared in cooperation with the police agencies surrounding our campus. This report includes statistics for the previous three calendar years concerning reported crimes that occurred on campus and on any public property within, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus. The report also includes institutional policies concerning campus security, alcohol and drug use, crime prevention, the reporting of crimes, sexual assault, VAWA, and other matters.
